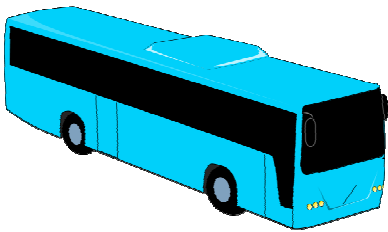

Intervale Center Fair Share Program



The Intervale Center Fair Share program runs for 16 weeks (starting July 11th) with food pickups every Monday at the Intervale Center. The food is from farms within the Intervale Center and Chittenden County and is anything they have in excess, can't sell to their wholesale markets, or anything with a little bit of bruising or pest damage. The veggies don't always look 100% (like they would at a farmers' market or the grocery store) but they are always perfectly delicious. All recipients' gross income (i.e. before taxes are withheld) must fall at or below 185 percent of the U.S. Poverty Income Guidelines. If they qualify for 3Squares or WIC, Free/Reduced School Lunch, are seniors, or on disability, they qualify. We just have folks sign a simple waiver on the first day of veggie pickup – we don't do any further verification. They'll also receive nutrition education, recipes, and samples!

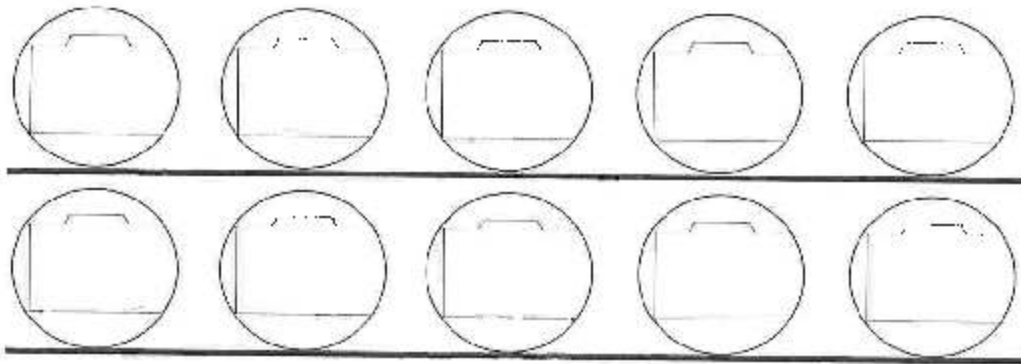

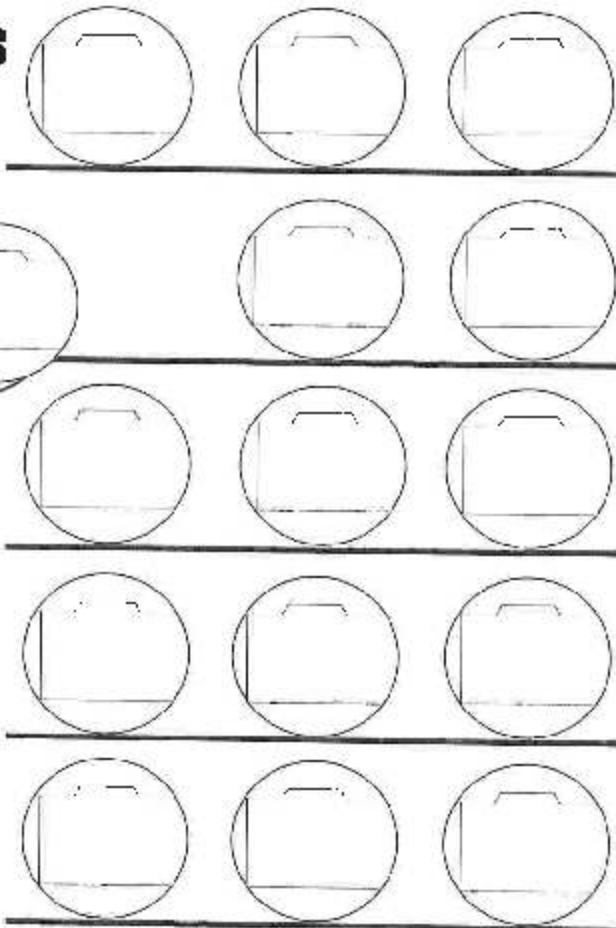
