Registering for Parent-Teacher Conferences

Our school had much success with the piloting of the PTC Fast conference registration system last year. We're eager to try it again!

This electronic scheduling of conferences allows for parents and guardians to select their own conference times at any point during the registration period, which begins Monday, September 29th and continues on until the week of conferences, which is Monday, October 13th. (Please do not wait until the last minute to schedule your conferences. You may not get the dates and times you wish.)

Teachers have prepared their conference schedules for Monday, October 13th through Thursday, October 16th, using this PTC Fast system. Via that website, this system will allow you to select the teacher(s) with whom you would like to hold a conference, and by registering your email address, you will be able to view and select an available meeting time that works for you.

The web link for Smith Parent Teacher Conference scheduling will become available on our school's home page (<http://smith.bsdyt.org>) on the morning of Monday, September 29th. Please note that if you are not able to access this system via the internet, you may complete the registration process at Curriculum Night (Tuesday, September 30th from 5:30-6:30 p.m.) using one of the library's computers.
