Our annual Math Night was held last evening. As I write this column, though, it is Wednesday morning, and Math Night is still a day away. We will have more information about Math Night in our next newsletter, which will be sent home on December 6th.



And now for a word or two about the upcoming school play, "Frankenstein," which will be presented in February. Rehearsals for the play will begin right after we come back from vacation in January and

will be held after school, beginning at 4:00 p.m. on most days. (Auditions will take place in December, just prior to vacation.) The Burlington Kids Afterschool Program (B.K.A.S.P.) will be coordinating the play, **but students do not have to be enrolled in that program in order to participate in the play. Students may show up at rehearsal time and not participate in the B.K.A.S.P. at all. Another option is for students to wait in the building from dismissal time (2:50 p.m. on most days) until rehearsals start at 4:00 p.m., and they will be provided with a snack and supervision by the program at no charge. If parents/guardians opt to have their children supervised by but not enrolled in the B.K.A.S.P., all that is needed is for an information sheet to be completed and returned to the main office at the school. This is emergency contact information only. It is not a registration for program activities other than the play, and there is no charge for that afternoon supervision or snack, thanks to the generosity of the Burlington Kids Afterschool Program.**
